

Instructions to set up model 48F Folding Dog Trap

- 1) Lay trap flat on surface
- 2) Use side of trap with handle to “release” locks.
- 3) Locks are located on the left hand and right hand side of handle.
- 4) Press down on trap – release each lock.
- 5) Lift top of trap forward and lay flat.
- 6) To open trap – lift up by either of the two handles.
- 7) Raise door panel side of trap (side with name plate)
- 8) Maneuver trap if needed to raise.
- 9) On each side of door panel locate spring locks – lock into place.
- 10) Repeat above to position the other door.

To use folding trap

Open rear door and place bait at the rear of the trip pan. Secure rear door. Some users prefer to tie bait to the trip pan. You may also use this rear panel if you need to release animal instead of rolling trap or using trap door. A TD1 divider is highly recommend so dog can be penned in trap with divider, reach through tines with restraint pole, put hoop over dogs neck, secure and pull out the divider. You then have an animal ready to lead off.

Left front door by lifting rings to free door to open. Hold door open and turn trigger rod on up left side to hold the door open. When animal walks on the trip pan, trigger will turn releasing the trap door.

To fold trap

- 1) Unlock end with name plate 1st (front of trap) Push up on locks.
- 2) Maneuver door to inside of trap.
- 3) Unlock other end (rear of trap) Push up on locks.
- 5) Remain standing on end of trap you completed last (rear door side) this is very important – so as the next step does not damage the trap.
- 6) Lay the trap down flat to your left.
- 7) Make sure handles of trap are laying down flat on left side.
- 8) Fold over trap to your right.
- 9) Secure in place with locks.
